THE RED ROUTE

The City Sightseeing Grand Tour of London's sights featuring Big Ben, Buckingham Palace, the Tower of London, Westminster Abbey, Piccadilly Circus, Trafalgar Square, St Paul's Cathedral, the Royal Courts of Justice, the Shard and the London Eye.

STOP NUMBER

- 1 Belvedere Road, behind the London Eye
- 2 Aldwych, outside One Aldwych Hotel
- 3 Ludgate Hill, St Paul's Cathedral entrance, opposite McDonald's
- 4 Queen Victoria Street, Bank Station, Stop MD
- 5 London Bridge, Monument, north of London Bridge, Stop P
- 6 Tooley Street, left of Potters Fields Park, Stop J
- 7 Tower Hill, Tower of London, bus stop in front of the Bronze Worker Statue
- 8 Victoria Embankment, opposite Temple Station, Stop W
- 9 Westminster Bridge (Big Ben side), in front of Westminster Pier
- 10 Horseferry Road, junction of Thorney Street, Stop NE

STOP NUMBER

- 11 Buckingham Gate, Buckingham Palace, opposite Queen's Gallery
- 12 Buckingham Palace Road, Victoria Station, outside Grosvenor Hotel
- 13 Buckingham Palace Road, Stop Z12
- 14 Grosvenor Gardens, Stop 10A
- 15 Hyde Park, Queen Elizabeth Gate, to the right of Achilles Statue
- 16 Marble Arch, Speakers' Corner, stop Z
- 17 Marble Arch, Park Lane, outside Bob Forstner showroom
- 18 Haymarket, outside Tiger Tiger bar restaurant
- 19 Pall Mall East, left of National Gallery, Stop Z
- 20 Westminster Bridge (the London Eye side), in front of the Marriot Hotel and next to the Lion Statue

THE GREEN ROUTE

A tour that takes in the British Museum, Platform 9 3/4 at Kings Cross Station, the literary area of Bloomsbury, Waterloo Station, the Royal National Theatre, the Royal Festival Hall, Bankside and the Leake Street Graffiti tunnels, and Lower Marsh Market.

Please be aware that the Green Route has only English commentary.
